## The American Experience 2023

LGBTQ+ respondents reported some of the highest levels of online hate and harassment of any groups surveyed

LGBTQ+

28% of LGBTQ+\* respondents reported severe harassment in the past 12 months, compared to 17% of non-LGBTQ+

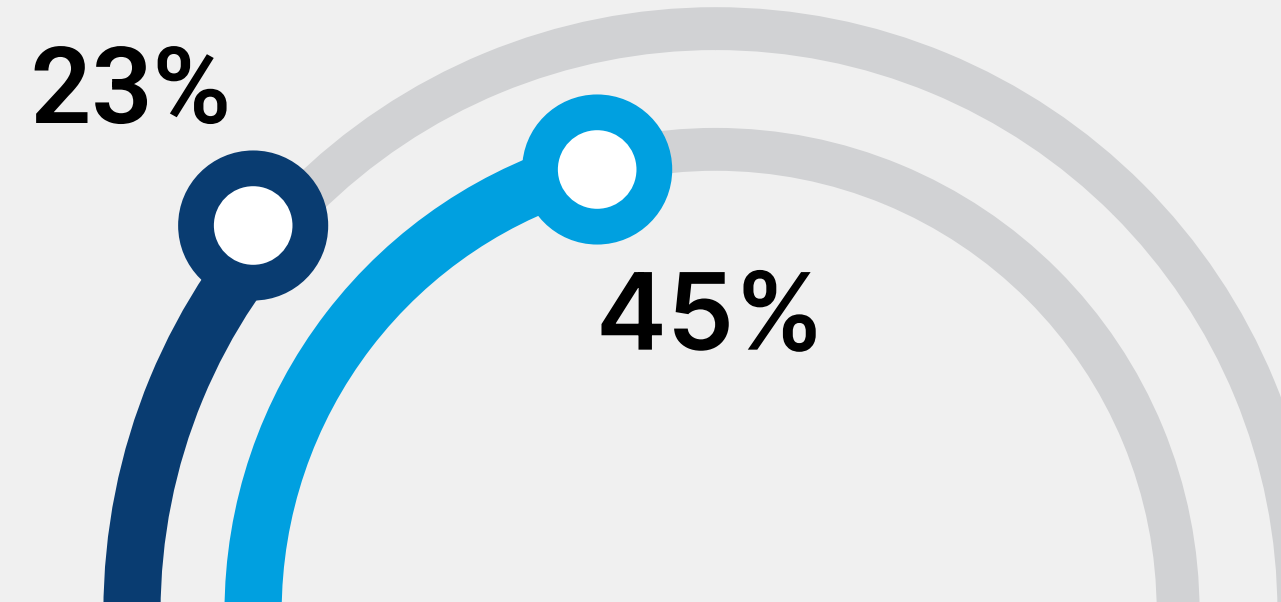

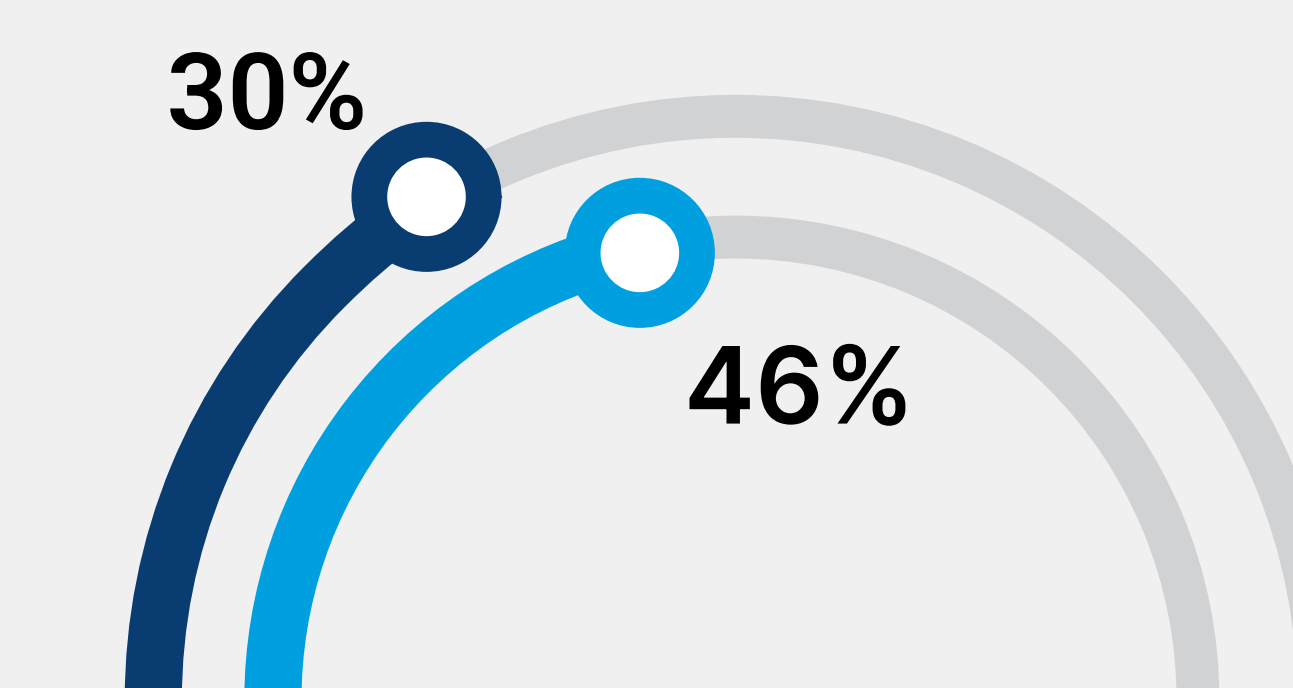
76% of transgender respondents have ever been harassed online and 60% have been harassed severely

Stalked

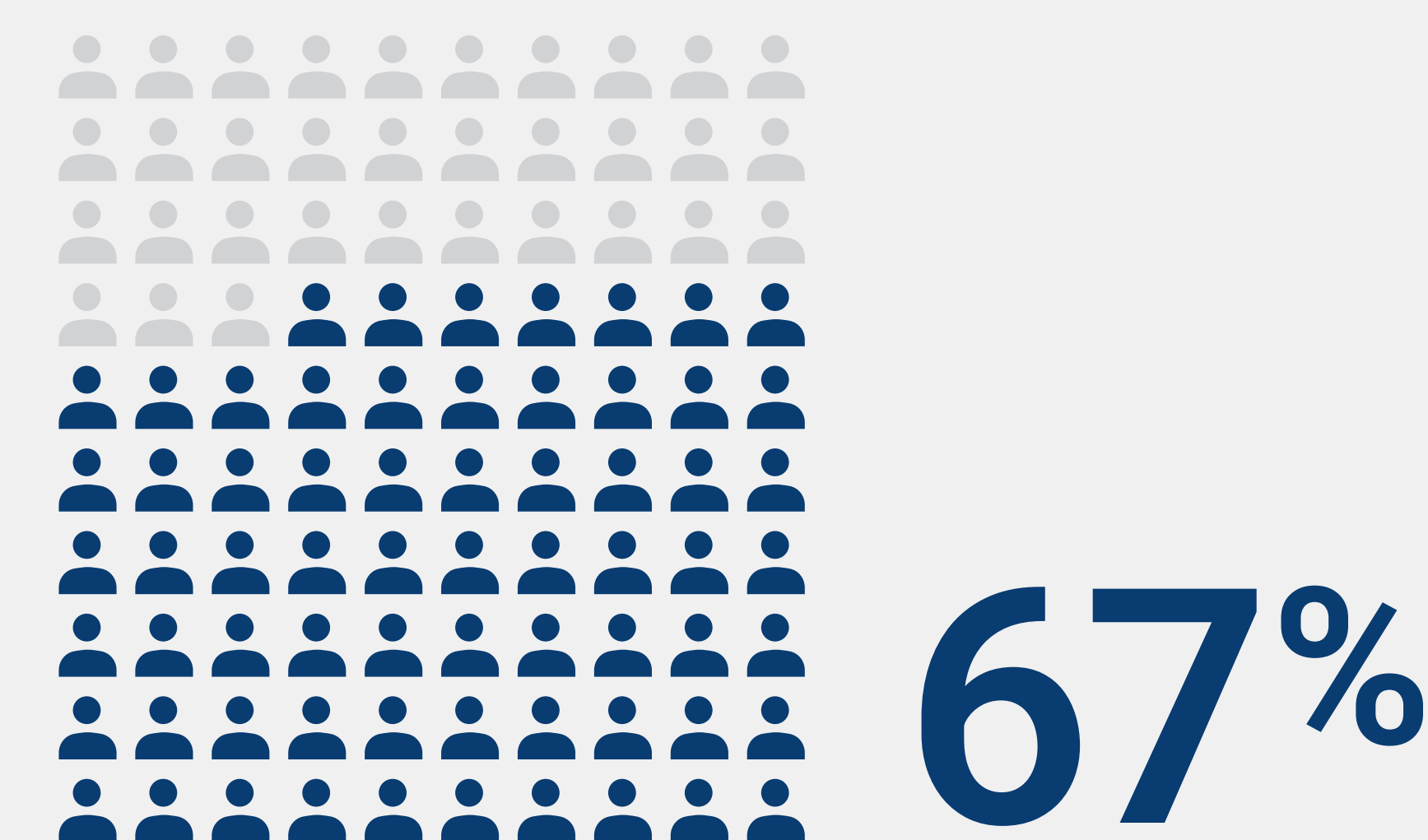
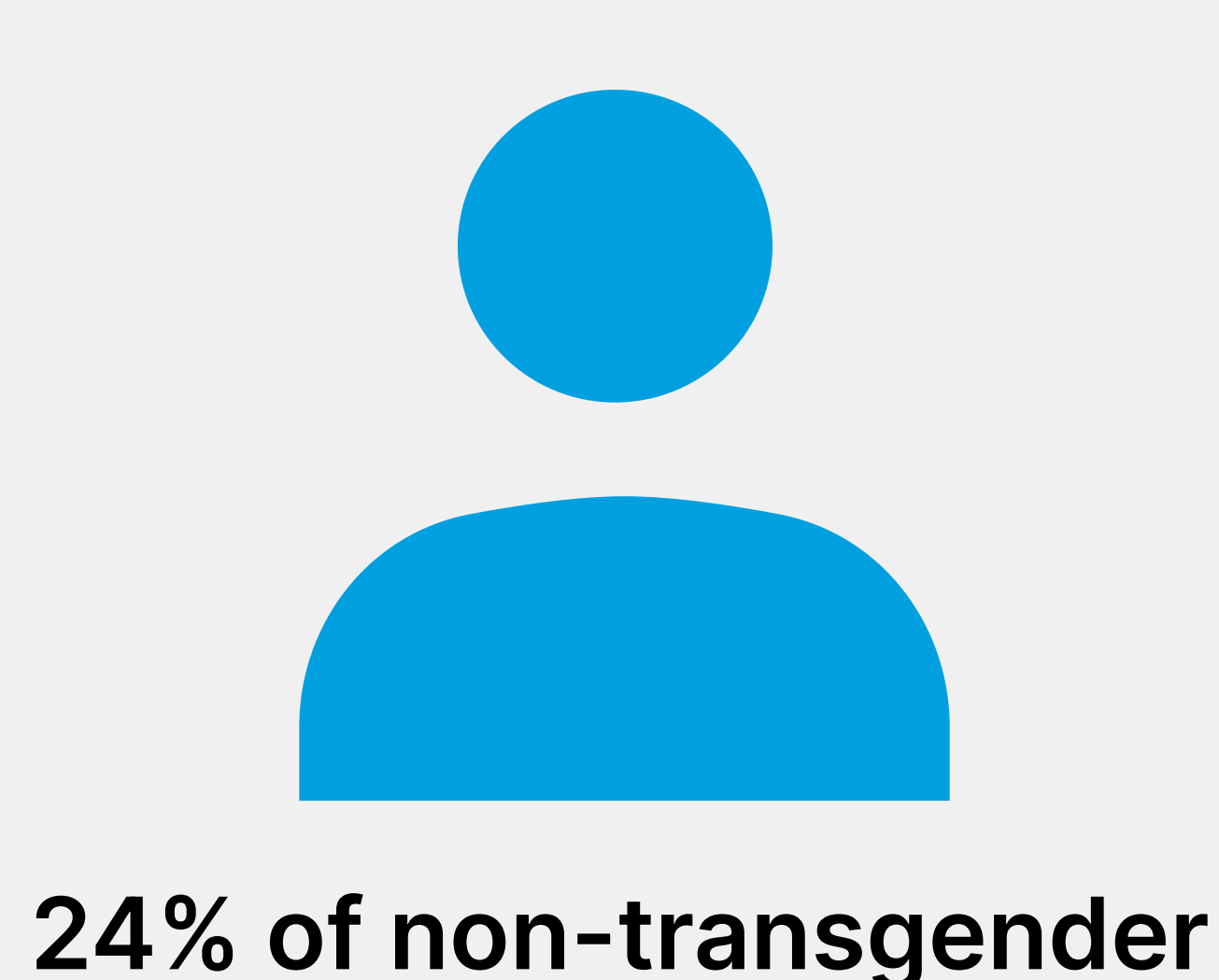


Sexually Harassed
